



## **VIDEO TRANSCRIPT:**

New York City (Manhattan, Bronx, Brooklyn, Queens and Staten Island) has enacted an important law - Gender-Motivated Violence Protection Law, known as the "Protection Law." This law empowers victims to take legal action against their attackers and any institutions—such as schools, churches, and workplaces—that helped or allowed the violence.

The types of violence covered by the Protection Law include:

- Sexual Assault or Rape
- Sexual Harassment
- False Imprisonment
- Verbal and Psychological Assault
- Stalking or Intimidation
- Child abuse

Please note that the Protection Law is set to expire on February 28, 2025. If you are a victim of gender-motivated violence, you can file a claim regardless of when the incident occurred. We urge

you to contact Eisenberg & Baum without delay. Our team is trained in ASL and is fully accessible to victims who are deaf, deafblind, or hard of hearing. If you know someone who might be eligible to file a lawsuit, please share this important legal information with them.
